How America Works Lesson 1: America's Democracy Grade 3

Objectives:

- 1. The students will be able to name the three branches of government.
- 2. The students will be able to compare the differences between the federal government, state government and local government.
- 3. The students will be able to recall what the system of checks and balances is.
- 4. The students will be able to identify the role of each branch of government.
- 5. The students will be able to choose the correct simple definition for democracy.

Kahoot*

Lesson:

- 1. (5min.) Introduction:
 - a. Ask: What is a democracy? Allow kids to guess.
 - b. Play the YouTube video.
 - c. Repeat the question, "What is a democracy?" **People rule by voting**.
 - d. Inform students that today we will learn about America's Democracy.
- 2. (15min.) Main Lesson:
 - a. Hand out Kids Discover: How America Works magazine and student packets
 - b. Read and discuss pages 2 and 3 of magazine.

Activity:

- 1. (15min.) Group Activity:
 - a. Students work with a partner to complete page 1 and 2 of student packet.
 - b. Check answers as a whole group.

Formative Assessment:

- 1. (10min.) Lesson Check:
 - a. Invite students to test their knowledge by playing the How America Works **Kahoot**. Students can play multiple times until they score 8+ out of 10.
